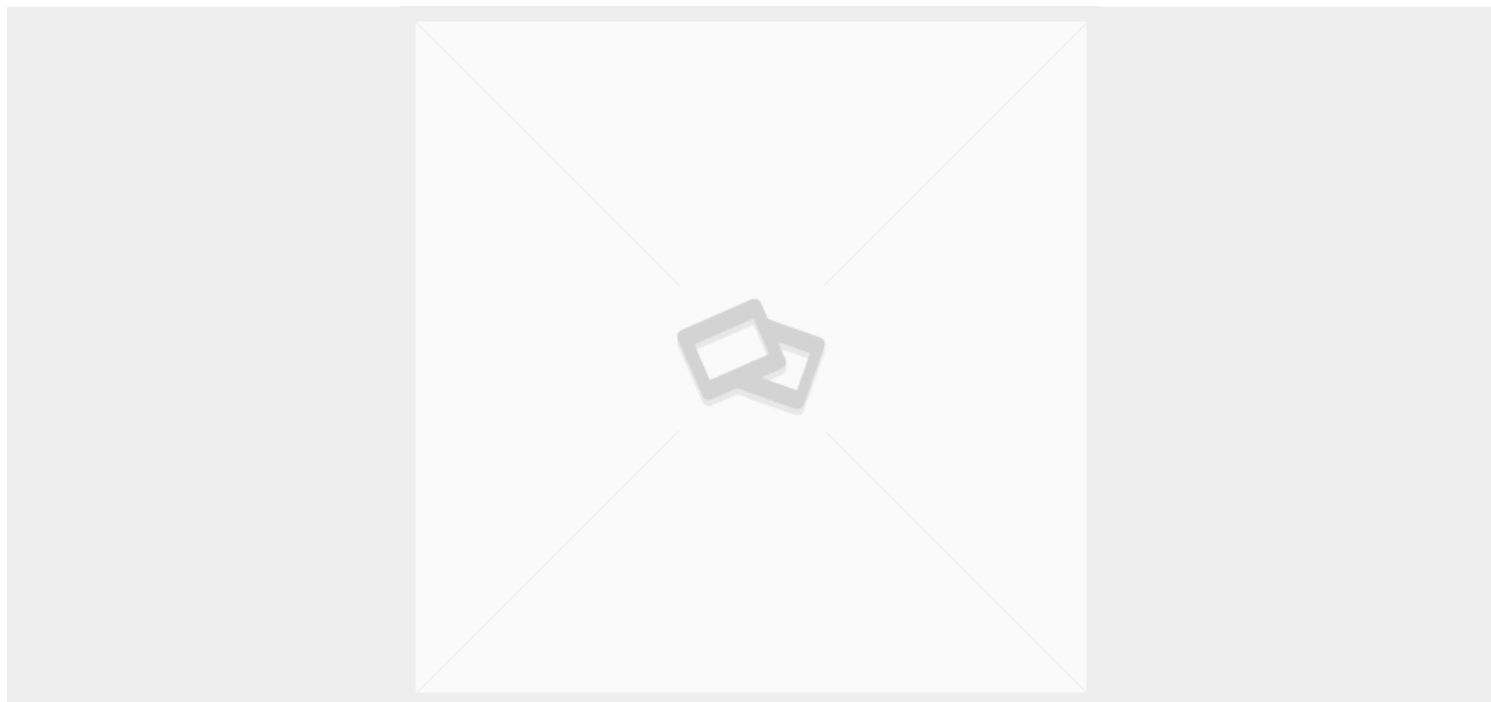
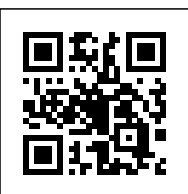

On Sept. 19, 1918, at the Battle of Arara (northern Palestine), Legion Armenienne (LA) defeated a combined German-Turkish forces to spur the final victorious campaign of the Allies in the Middle East. The LA was an all-voluntary regiment for 4,500 Armenian soldiers.
