

# FASCISTS AMONG US

There are many ways to violate someone's fundamental human right of free speech, from a bullet in the neck and the Gulag to censorship and a steady barrage of insults. Some day, in a future progressive and enlightened Armenian democracy, if our partisans are arrested and put on trial, they will be absolutely right in pleading not guilty by reason of insanity.

To recycle propaganda means to allow others to do your thinking for you; which also means to abdicate your responsibility as a human being and to repudiate one of the most precious possessions that God or the forces of the universe have endowed you: your brain.

The evil is not Turkish, German, Italian, or Russian fascism; but fascism, period! including Armenian fascism.
