Anonymous articles can be interpreted as a bunch of people who have an axe to grind or are fishing in murky waters. Violence is reality, particularly among Armenians who could not engage in civil discourse and would settle their grievances by brute force. If Keghart.com has a soft heart towards the safety of those who published the anonymous letter, the publication should not have given an uncontrolled forum to air their grievances without unearthing the root causes of those grievances. The anonymous article impressed me that it was written by Pashinian partisans. I could be wrong. However, rather than give a rogue group hiding behind anonymity, why doesn't Keghart.com approach the issue in honest journalistic manner by assigning a correspondent to interview those anonymous authors or concerned individuals about the sanctity of their party, understand their allegations, grievances, double or triple check validity of sources and the truthfulness of their allegations and write an article by making anonymous references under their own bylines. This will, at least be guaranteed by implied trust in the honesty of the journalist, presumably he or she does not have a political axe to grind. Better yet have a non Armenian Journalist assigned to take the task on. The sanctity and trust of Keghart.com should be paramount by not publishing any article without journalistic filter. I agree with Harout Sassounian, although I disagree with his assertion that If you don't want to append your name then shut up. Trusted Free press is the hallmark of democracy and often they do it by giving cover to their sources. They can do that because they have earned readers trust that what they publish is rarely erroneous, and if it is discovered to be erroneous, they issue corrections to their error. Th only way an open forum in a journalistic organization without control should be in an opinion column. And in an opinion column the opinion author's identity should be clearly verified and displayed. If not, then it should not be published. The power of the word is mightier than the sword and it should not be treated lightly.

If one or more persons wish to express their opinion, they should have the courage to sign their names. This has nothing to do with political partisanship. It has everything to do with journalistic ethics. I have been the editor/publisher of the California Courier for 40 years. I have written thousands of often controversial editorials during those years, yet, never once, I have published anything without signing my name. I also have not published anyone else's letter to the editor, opinion column or article without the writer's real name. No anonymous articles, no initials, and no pseudonyms. I suggest Keghart adopt such a proper journalistic policy. Everyone can support anyone or anything they want. Just have the courage to sign your name.
