

ORIGIN OF OORPAT (FRIDAY IN ARMENIAN)

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The Armenian "oorpat" (Friday) derives from "arub shabbat"/"erweba dshab'ba" of Assyrian-Semitic, meaning "preparation"—in this case for Saturday. To keep Shabbat sacred, the Assyrians had to prepare everything one day before the sacred day of rest. In Old Armenian "Oorpayoutiun" means preparation.

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
