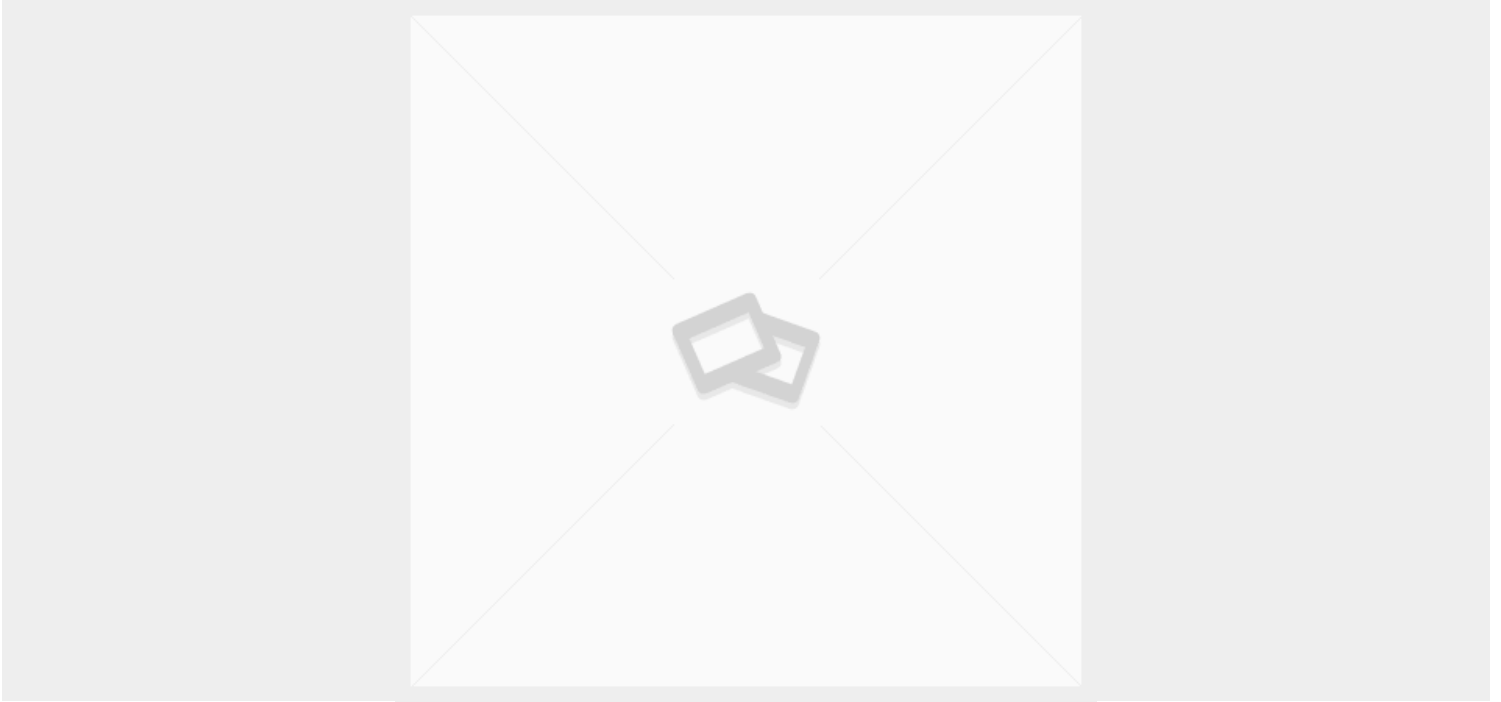


PATRIARCH HOVHANNES' SOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE ARMENIAN CONVENT OF JERUSALEM
