Another brother (Aviet) was brought to manage the Eastern, while Tigran extended the Oriental to reopen in 1889 as the Eastern & Oriental or E & O as it was known for generation of planter and officials. In 1891 a fourth brother (Arshag) arrived to improve the E&O until it became known as the best hotel east of Suez. Tigran and Martin opened another hotel in Singapore (1887). They named it Raffles.
