Sometimes the obvious looks right in your face but you fail to recognize it. There's such a scenario these days but in big international dimensions.

Following in the footsteps of Australia, Britain has drafted a plan to "export" her illegal asylum seekers. While in the past decade Australia relocated about 4,000 asylum seekers in New Guinea and on several Pacific Ocean islands, Britain has made a deal with Rwanda to send a much-larger number of asylum seekers to that African country more than 7,000 kilometers away. Last year about 30,000 illegal asylum seekers landed in Britain. Britain reports that it recently approached Armenia, Botswana, Costa Rica, and Ivory Coast for a similar agreement.

Midway Britain and Rwanda, there's another country which has a severe immigration problem: the nearly two-million Palestinians of Gaza. The genocidal government of Israel intends to evict Palestinians from their homeland. Cayman: Khayma means "two tents."

Yallahs: This place name in Jamaica means "Twice oh, God" in Palestinian.

There is an "Orient Bay" in St. Maarten.

Suffrere is a volcanic mountain in St. Lucia. It means "Zero" in Palestinian.

Nagua (Dominican Republic). It's Arab feminine name meaning "intimate conversation."

Balash (Aruba) means "free."

Cidra is in Puerto Rico. There's also a Sidra in Libya.

"Bannetyne" is another one. It means "two girls or two daughters."

Fyzabad (Trinidad) is a Middle Eastern place name.

Candille (Antilles) means candles.

Southwest of the Caribbean in Colombia are Cartagena and Palmyra. Cartagena is a city in Tunisia founded by Lebanese navigators. Palmyra is an ancient city in the Syrian Desert. There are scores of other Arabic place names in the region. Considering the similarity in Caribbean and Palestinian languages, Gaza Palestinians would feel at home in their Caribbean homeland while Benjamin Netanyahu and his lunatic-murderous fringe Itamar Ben Gvir, Bezalel Smotrich, Yoam Gallant and the rest of the millions of Israelis who will boast they facilitated the settling of Palestinians in the sunny Caribbean.
